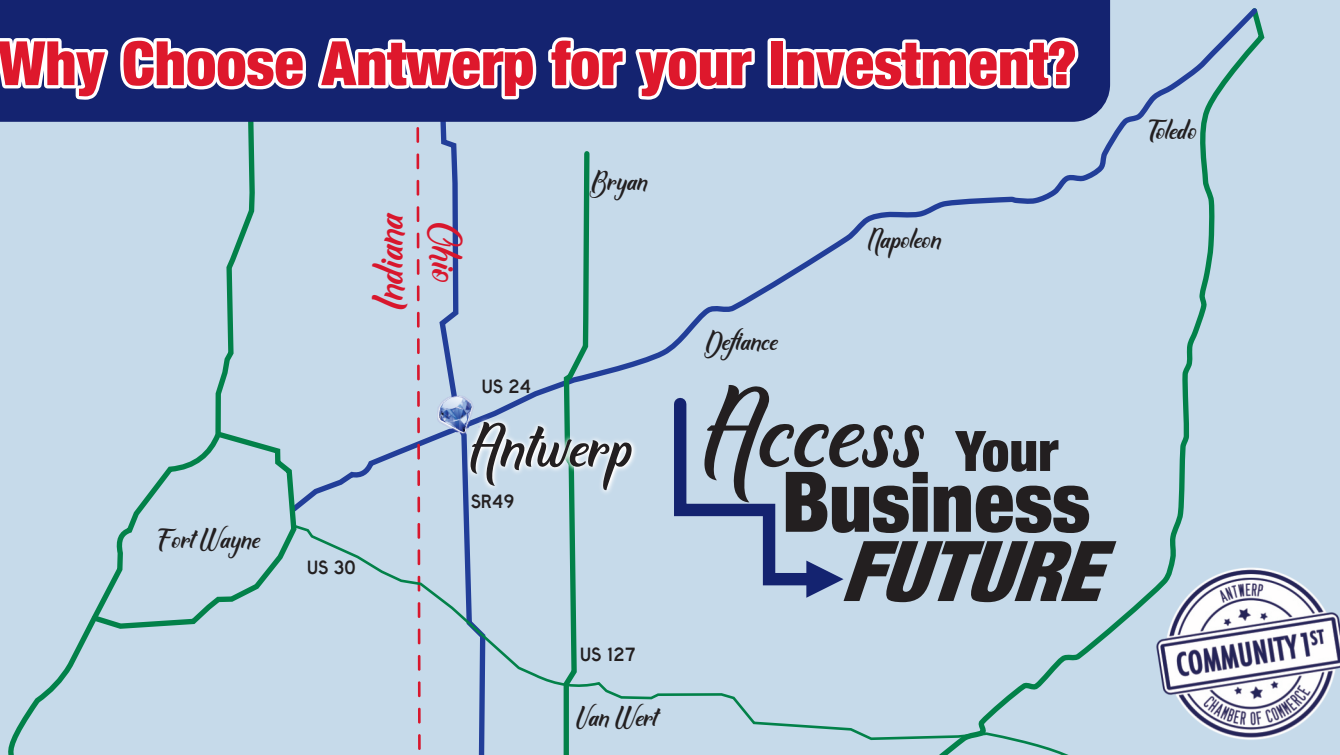


Why Choose Antwerp for your Investment?

DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES ABOUND



CROSSROADS OF THE MIDWEST

Of the multiple reasons to choose Antwerp, the best might be the ease of access to various locales with US 24. Antwerp is the only town in Paulding County with full access ramps and exits to the four lane highway that connects Toledo, Defiance, New Haven and Fort Wayne. The small size of the community means your trucks and vehicles have the ability to easily reach other destinations quickly at less cost than other comparable towns.

The intersection of State Route 49 with US 24 also means reaching US 30, 33 and I-75 all within a few miles reach. Antwerp really is the center of the best highway connections available in the area. The original US 24 is also an alternative route that connects Bryan and other prime northwest Ohio cities.

PUBLIC UTILITIES

Public water, sewer, and trash pick up are all readily available throughout the village of Antwerp. The city water infrastructure is in the process of getting an upgrade proving to be an asset to the community and businesses of the area. Not only does the village of Antwerp provide potable water, it also has storm and sanitary sewer options. Sanitation providers for the village of Antwerp business community and residential community are coordinated with Real Waste in Oakwood, Ohio.

INTERNET

Providers include Metalink, Mediacom, AT&T, T-Mobile, and much more. Fiber optic, wireless, cable, and DSL are all options available in the village. Communications in Antwerp has never been better!
